His description: physically - 1Sam. 16:12

spiritually - 1Sam. 13:14; Acts 13:22; Ps.78:70ff

"a man after my own heart"

"David . . . his servant"

The event: 1Sam. 17:33-35

1. His character: developed in the solitude, obscurity, & monotony of keeping sheep in the fields

2. Responsible = committed to his task, whatever it was

3. Integrity = what you are when no one is looking

4. v. 36 . . . His reaction = nothing new to David; it was merely a display of what he was every day, even when alone.

Not surprised at killing Goliath because this was not the first giant he had killed; had been doing this as a normal part of his everyday work.
